Nigel Stonham Coaching English Strategy Happiness

English – Various methods used to increase confidence, fluency, and comprehension. Such as songs and sound and lyrics as basis for discussion and learning. Started building three new programs 1. a “Mr Men” program for kids starting with Mr Happy, 2. a “Bend it like Beckham” program for teens using the book, film and musical, and 3. a series of lessons based on “43 words to provoke thought!” for teens and adults. Looking to pilot more in Vienna and scale up with freelance trainers under blue sky stuff academy.

Strategy Mentoring – based on goal achievement, and GOST© methodology. A. Define goals and key objectives. B. Create strategies and tactics. C. Review and refine a single sheet summary, using logical incrementalism, creativity, and an holistic approach.

Happiness Coaching – with or without discussion about what happiness is or might be, focus is on increasing happiness of people stating they feel 7 or more out of 10 on a happiness scale. They define their key objectives to a happier state. With that as the goal, we work on strategies and tactics to enable or re-enable their happiness.

blue sky stuff

“inspiring and motivating people to find and follow their passion”

Formation of clear plans for the blue sky stuff academy. Intention to offer lifelong lifewide training (starting with ICT, Languages, and Arts) to the players, fans and community of FC Mariahilf. Advertise events through WienXtra monthly calendar to reach audience and promote the football club. The project optimizes local trainers and venues, and creates value in the form of education and jobs.

Intend to collaborate with Coderdojo (a global organisation offering free computer programming workshops for teenagers) by running a project to set up 23 coderdojos in Wien in 2017.

Vienna Hub

“Connecting people with passion across art commerce sport education”

Vienna Hub aims to support a sustainable life based on people’s passion, through an umbrella organization offering elements of business required but perhaps lacking, for example legal, linguistic, sales, marketing or finance.

Creative Circles was born towards the end of the year, fulfilling a long held aim to restart monthly gatherings. Based on the GOST© methodology, creative circles met in November and December at Aux Gazelles, to share collective wisdom toward goal achievement. Monthly dates planned through 2017 on the Second Tuesday.

Women with Passion

Created the “Women with Passion 2017” Yearbook, and a **PopUpPassion** pilot event was held on Monday 12th Dec. at radlager.at. People networked, met new people, and shared passion over early morning

coffee and croissants. Future events booked for Jan 9th and Feb 13th then monthly intention.

Vienna Happiness Project

Started in 2010 with an art event on digital screens, this has grown steadily in energy. It followed on from “Moedling, Happiest City on Earth”.

Launched Happy City Network intending to have 527 cities represented in Wien in a 2019 gathering. Similarly launched Happy Schools Network with intention of 527 Schools represented in Wien in 2018. Liasing with Bristol, Ottawa, Vancouver and other city, national, and international initiatives.

Happiest Street in Town

Connecting people on Gumpendorfer Strasse with their neighbours both online and offline this project intended a series of events in week of 19th December. Derailed by flu. Events included Happy Eating, Mr Happy Hours, Happy Coffee. Created the eZine/ magazine “Happiest Street in Town” which intends to raise 40,000 euros locally for FC Mariahilf.

Planned for Feb 3rd - the first “Gumpendorfer Strasse -Walk of Happiness”, a street long celebration of happiness.
